SilverZone Olympiad

November 9-25, 2024

The SilverZone Olympiad, which provides students with a platform to excel in various subjects, was conducted throughout November 2024. Students from the school participated across a wide range of disciplines, showcasing their enthusiasm for academic excellence.

The participation included 27 students in Social Sciences, 105 in English, 207 in Mathematics, 139 in Science, 42 in Computer Science, 53 in Reasoning and Aptitude, 7 in Hindi, 49 in General Knowledge, 20 in Talent Hunt, and 20 in STEM.

Science Quiz November 26, 2024




